

# *Chalk Art with Classic Amy Joanne*

## *Mirror Mirror*

Design by Amy Joanne Mogish

Mirror Mirror on the wall, I am my Mother after all.....this is for you Mom!

### **Supplies**

Prismacolor Pencil, White  
Pattern (Instruction/Supply List, Pattern, Photo)  
Mirror - 09-9127 vikingwoodcrafts.com  
Sponge Roller  
Paper Plates (for paint)  
Paper Towels  
Deco Art Black Chalkboard Paint  
Deco Art Graphite Paint  
Deco Art Neutral Gray Paint  
2" Chip Brush (or smaller)

Electric Pencil Sharpener (for initial point)  
Hand Held Pencil Sharpener (to freshen point)  
Lead Pencil (tracing/sharpening)  
Stylus  
Tracing Paper  
White (transfer) Graphite Paper  
Deco Art Matte Spray Varnish  
Embellishments if desired  
Favorite Glue

### **Special Tips and Techniques**

Initially sharpen your pencil with an electric sharpener. A hand held sharpener can be used after initial sharpening to freshen the point. Keep your pencil sharp. Do not sharpen # end of pencil.

Turn your pencil thru-out penciling, this will keep the point sharp and will not form a flat spot on your pencil tip.

To shade - find a starting point and apply normal pressure on the pencil, move your pencil in circles from side to side, soften and lift on pressure as you blend into background. The background is your hi-light, (negative space). This is just another layer, not more pressure.

Read all instructions prior to beginning. The instructions are intended as a guide and not a 1, 2, 3 step process.

Refer to photos as needed.

## Let's Begin

Remove Mirror and prepare the wood (both sides) by sponge rolling 2 coats of **Black Chalk Board Paint**, let dry.

Prepare a 'chip' brush as you would a drybrush, **Graphite Paint**. (drybrush: dip tip of brush into paint, remove excess paint onto paper towel). Apply to the wood (both sides) by rotating the brush in circles to create swirls with some pressure, leaving some of the outside edges black. Reload the brush if necessary. Repeat with less of **Neutral Grey Paint**, let dry.

Trace the design onto tracing paper using a lead pencil and pattern. Align the traced design onto the prepared wood. Slide the white graphite paper under tracing paper and with your stylus transfer the pattern onto the wood, use very light pressure, so not to score the wood, but still able to see the tracing when completed. Transfer part of the design to the handle of the opposite side of the mirror if desired.

## Developing the Design

The design is developed with a **White PrismaColor Pencil**, leaving the background work as your hi-lighted areas. Refer to photo. Use 'normal' pressure.

Pencil (line) over all graphite lines.

Color 'in' all letters and comma's and dots.

Shade along all outside edges of comma's and dots. This is just another layer using shading method. Do not press harder on your pencil.

Rub outside edge of wood mirror with side of pencil to create 'worn' look.

## Finishing

Sign and date your piece.

Apply 2 coats of spray varnish with back and forth motion to penciled piece. Let dry in between coats.

Add embellishments if desired. I added a mini-frame and photo copied a favorite photo, then adhered to the frame, along with the mirror.

A simple reminder of how special my Mom is to me!
